

## UNAMERICAN UNFAMOUS - Brooklyn CALL FOR SUBMISSIONS

We are seeking photographic portraits of 'unsung Brooklynites' for inclusion in Clive Holden's UNAMERICAN UNFAMOUS - Brooklyn, an artwork and year-long community interaction. The making of the artwork will culminate in an exhibition from July 20 to August 30, 2023, at KAM/the Kingsborough Art Museum.

CRITERIA FOR CONSIDERATION: the photo's subjects must be from, or connected to, Brooklyn; they need to be unfamous; and we need to be able to see their faces quite well. The photos can be old/new, formal/street/family snapshot, and film/digital/b&w/colour. They can even be damaged or glitched.

THIS ARTWORK: will be an electronic, moving image, visual artwork about the size of a Greyhound Bus. It will be made of code, including a network of algorithmic chance procedures that will 'play' the artwork like it's a song – a visual song that includes rhythm and harmony – but also improvisation. It will complete itself, live, while we watch, and every viewing will be unique. It will be as dynamic as Brooklyn itself.
